Mittens/Gloves



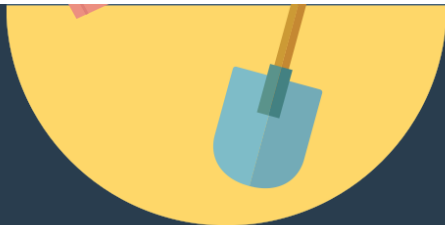
Candle/matches/tin can

Your chances for survival greatly increase when you stay with your vehicle.

Items for your vehicle:



Booster cables
Flashlight with extra batteries



- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Ice scraper
- Emergency flares & reflectors
- Shovel
- Tow chain or rope
- Road salt, sand, or cat litter

Winter storms can be unpredictable. Be prepared for the worst.

Items for you:

- Bottled water
- High-calorie nonperishable food
- 1st aid kit



Periodically check your supplies to make sure you are fully stocked & that nothing has expired.



Always carry a cellphone in the event you need to call 911. Don't forget the charger!



Keep your gas tank at half full or more before leaving on a trip.



Make sure to check the weather before heading out the door.



If you need to travel in unfavorable conditions, let someone know your route.
